
Language and Literacy Development


Oral language development

Oral Language Development Books introduce young learners to the English language and help them build their vocabulary through engaging activities, stories, songs and games.

Oral Language Development Home Play Books offer each learner an opportunity to continue their learning at home in a playful manner.







Writing Practice Books provide practice in writing both capital and small letters, followed by words and short sentences.



Word Recognition Books develop reading skills in young learners through letter-sound correspondence, phonological awareness and visual recognition.

Rhymes Books offer an excellent opportunity for blending music with language development, phonological awareness and kinaesthetic learning.





Storybooks integrate Indian stories, fostering language skills, imagination and creativity in young learners.

Alphabet Book helps young learners become familiar with the letters of the English alphabet by focusing on letter-case differentiation, letter-object relationships and letter formation.




